

### **Idaho Rivers**

#### Science - Grade 4-6

# Students label the major rivers and towns of Idaho on a map.

#### Materials:

- Wildlife worksheet (see following page)
- Colored pencils
- Map of Idaho for reference

#### Instructions:

- Ask students to brainstorm names of rivers in Idaho. They should come up with
  a pretty extensive list. If you have an overhead projector, draw an outline map
  of Idaho and ask the students to come up and draw in the location of some of
  the rivers. You might have a few students who can easily do this. However,
  many students may know the names of rivers but cannot place them on a map.
- 2. Tell students that they will be learning where major rivers of Idaho are by looking at a map and labeling them on an outline map.
- 3. Hand out the attached worksheet. Use textbooks or maps to locate and label some of the following (add some of your own too!)
